Royal Army medical Corps Died 25/1/17 age 22years



Private Arthur Ashworth, the son of a Bury butcher, was discharged from the army after a bout of pneumonia. He resumed his pre-war job at the family-run Fernhill Chemical works but died suddenly in his sleep on 25th January 1917, aged 22.

His name is on the Roll of Honour at Bank Street Unitarian Church. He is buried at Holebottom in a Commonwealth War Grave.
