Mrs Entwistle of 362 Bolton Road, Hawkshaw, has received an official intimation that her husband, Private Arthur Entwistle (better known in Ramsbottom, of which place he was a native, by the name of Brown) was killed in action on November 30th. He had been in France eight months. Previous to enlistment he was employed at Redisher Works, Holcombe Brook. His name is on the roll of honour at Hawkshaw Church. He leaves a wife and one child. Letters of condolence have been received from his senior officer on behalf of the officers and men, and from the chaplain (Reverend Walter H Fawkes) who writes: 'you will probably have received official notice before this letter reaches you, acquainting you with news of your husband. Our battalion (the ---- Lancashire Fusiliers) has been in the line and I regret to say that your husband was killed in action on November 30th.
