

Gunner Harry Wild Royal Field Artillery Service Number 10119 Killed In action 1/7/16

Mr and Mrs Wild, of 115, Ingham Street Bury, have received an official intimation that their son Gunner Harry Wild, of the Royal Field Artillery, was killed in action on July $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$. He was 17 years of age, and prior to enlisting two years ago was employed by Mr Holt, tinplate worker of Buckley Street, and his name is on the Bank Street Unitarian Sunday School roll of honour. His brother, sapper Joseph Wild, is in the Royal Engineers.
