

Private Richard Ainsworth King's Liverpool Regiment Died 21/2/- aged 21 years served France

Mr and Mrs Ainsworth of 94 Edward Street, Bury, have received official information that their son Private Richard Ainsworth of the King's Liverpool Regiment, die from pneumonia in the 10th Clearing Hospital on France on February 21st. The following letter has also been received from a sister in the hospital dated February 22nd: - 'I am very sorry to inform you that your son, Private Richard Ainsworth, died at this hospital, yesterday, at 2pm. He was very il with pneumonia, and was admitted to the hospital at ten O'clock the previous night. He will be buried at the little cemetery near the hospital'. Private Ainsworth, who was 21 years of age, was formerly employed at Mr Ratcliffe Taylor's Dyeworks, Gigg. He attended Bank Street Unitarian Sunday School and was amember of the young men's club. His name is on the roll of honour at the school.
