

Private Hubert Taylor Lancashire Fusiliers 1<sup>st</sup> /5<sup>th</sup> Batt Killed in action 12/7/15 aged 19 years Gallipoli

Information has been received, though not officially, that Pte. Hubert Taylor, of the 1<sup>st</sup> /5<sup>th</sup> Batt. Lancashire Fusiliers has been killed in the Dardanelles. He was the son of Mr Joe Taylor, (deceased) of I Elm Street, Bury, and joined the Territorials in August. He was 19 years of age, and one of the guard of honour at Cairo on the appointment of a new Governor of Egypt in January, the guard being composed of 100 selected men on the 5<sup>th</sup> Batt. Lancashire Fusiliers. Pte. Taylor was employed at Messrs. J Wrigley & Sons' Paper Mill, and was connected with Bank Street Sunday School. He was brother of Corporal W Taylor, who is a clerk in the battalion at the Bury Drill Hall.
