Mr Robert Leak, of Crosshall Farm, Chesham, has received a letter intimating that his son Private Nathan Leak, of the Lancashire Fusiliers, is reported missing. The letter which was sent by one of his comrades stated that he was last seen in a position in advance of his battalion attending to some wounded. Thirty years of age Private Leak joined the forces in March of this year, going to France about June. He was employed prior to joining up, by Mr J. H. Bolton, carrier, and his name is on the roll of honour at Chesham Unitarian Church.

Mr Robert Leak, of Crosshall Farm, Walmersley, has received official intimation that his brother, Private Nathan Leak of the Lancashire Fusiliers, who had resided with him, has died from wounds on December 2<sup>nd</sup>. A letter had previously been received in Bury from a comrade ( see above). In one notice received it stated he was a prisoner of war. Private Leak, who was 29 years of age and single, joined the forces in March this year.
