Mrs Bracewell (daughter of R H Toothill, Newmarket Hotel, Bury) has received a letter from Pte A Doherty as follows:- It is with deepest regret that I write these few lines to inform you that your husband, Pte Stanley Bracewell got killed while in action with his regiment on July 6<sup>th</sup>. He was in my company and the lads miss him very much. I am sure it will console you to know that he died a hero's death while fighting for his King and country. Pte. Bracewell was a native of Bury and had been in the service of Bury Corporation Tramways for many years. He commenced as a points boy, and was afterwards a tram conductor. He enlisted on September 12<sup>th</sup> a month after the outbreak of war, in the Manchester Regiment and had been fighting in the ranks in France for over twelve months. A short time ago he was recommended for the D.C.M. for obtaining useful information while scouting.
